

## Applying for a Queensland Rural Generalist Pathway Intern position

The Queensland Rural Generalist Pathway (QRGP) Intern campaign is administered exclusively by the QRGP team. We offer support and guidance throughout the campaign and can be contacted in the lead up to and during the application period with any questions you may have.

Applications are completed online during the application opening period (usually March for commencement the following year). The information below is designed to help you to gather supporting documentation and start thinking about your selection criteria responses before applications officially open.

### Documents required for application

*Note: documents do not need to be signed by a JP*

1. A copy of your Australian/New Zealand Passport or evidence of Australian/New Zealand citizenship; or current passport plus evidence of Australian permanent visa and a copy of a Visa Entitlement Verification (VEVO); or a copy of your birth certificate and marriage certificate; or a copy of your driver licence.
2. Passport size photo.
3. Curriculum Vitae with two referees (referee must be able to comment on your professional, clinical and interpersonal skills).
4. Details regarding exam results (entered directly into the application).
5. A completed Queensland Health Criminal History Check form (this is available to be completed at application time).
6. Evidence of Hepatitis B immunisation – provide one of the following: letter from a general practitioner, infection control, or occupational health department stating vaccination details; or copy of vaccine immunity record book; or blood test that shows the required level of immunity (i.e. anti HBs>10IU/L).

### Selection criteria

The offer of a QRGP Intern training position is determined by ranked merit against the selection criteria in the written application and at interview. A written response to the selection criteria listed below is required at the time of application.

*Word limit for each selection criteria: 400 words*

#### Selection criteria 1

Your current credentials in life, work, community participation or other relevant areas which demonstrates your professional and personal preparedness for the challenges of rural and remote and/or regional practice.



## Selection criteria 2

Evidence of your action and dedication to acquire the knowledge and skills essential for practice in a rural, remote or regional setting.

## Selection criteria 3

Your capacity and commitment to work in a Queensland rural practice / hospital upon completion of Prevocational and Advanced Skills Training in Rural Generalist Medicine.

## Queensland Health intern applicant groups

All medical students applying for internship in Australia are allocated an applicant group as outlined below. Applicants in the Group A and Group B categories are eligible to apply for a QRGP intern position.

Applicant Group	Definition
Group A	Medical graduates of Queensland universities who are Australia/New Zealand citizens or Australian permanent residents; and:  - are seeking an internship commencing in the year immediately following graduation; OR - received Review Committee approval from a previous campaign to defer commencement of internship
Group B	Medical graduates of Queensland universities or New Zealand universities who are Australian/New Zealand citizens or Australian permanent residents who:  - do not meet the criteria outlined in Group A or - Medical graduates of Australian (interstate) or New Zealand universities who are Australian / New Zealand citizens or Australian permanent residents.
<b>Group C &amp; D</b>	<b>Not eligible to apply for a Queensland Rural Generalist intern position</b>
Group C	Medical graduates of Australian (Queensland or interstate) or New Zealand universities who are NOT Australian / New Zealand citizens or Australian permanent residents who: -  - currently hold a visa that allows them to work in Australia; OR - will need to obtain a visa to work in Australia
Group D	Medical graduates of AMC accredited universities located outside of Australia or New Zealand. or Medical graduates of international universities who have not completed an internship in Australia or another country and have either:  - obtained the AMC Certificate (and are eligible for provisional registration) - successfully completed the AMC MCQ (multiple choice questionnaire) (and are eligible for limited registration)
