

Advice Regarding Employment in Unsupervised Positions

The QRGP team is aware of a small number of trainees engaging in employment with after-hours medical services and other unsupervised positions. This situation raises serious concerns for the safety of patients and the professional risks incurred by the trainees should they not have adequate supervision as non-vocationally qualified doctors.

Unsupervised clinical practice prior to completion of fellowship training does not align with the strategic direction of the QRGP and therefore cannot be supported or recommended. The team strongly recommends trainees involved in or considering such employment seek professional advice on the subject, including from your indemnity provider and Regional Training Organisation (RTO).
