

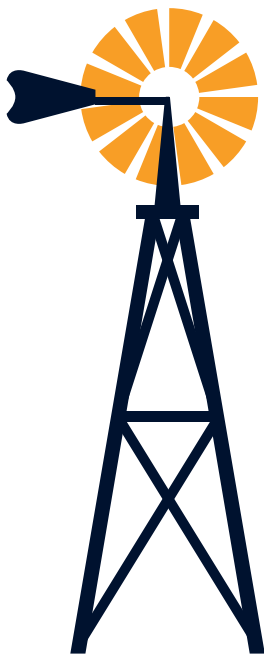

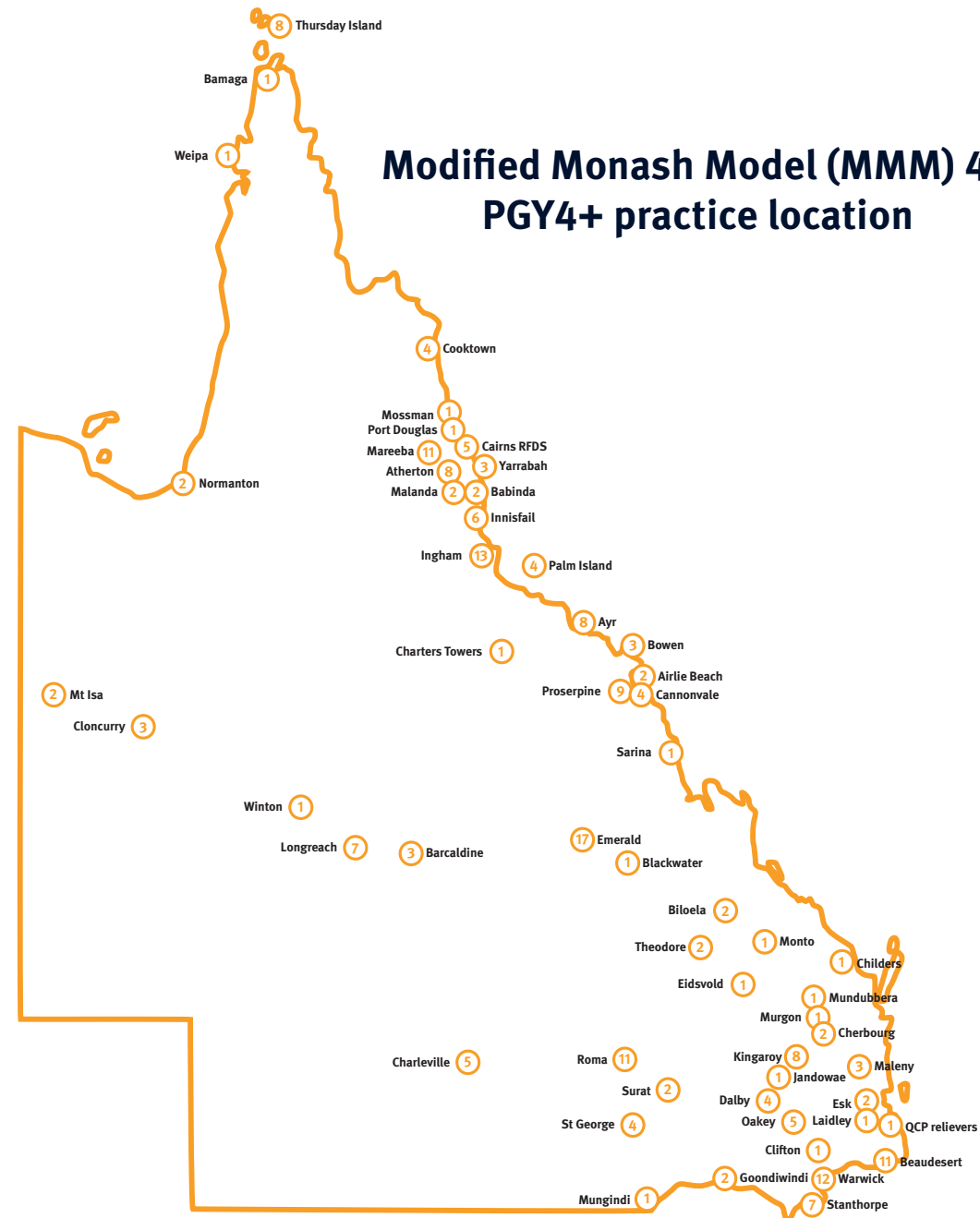

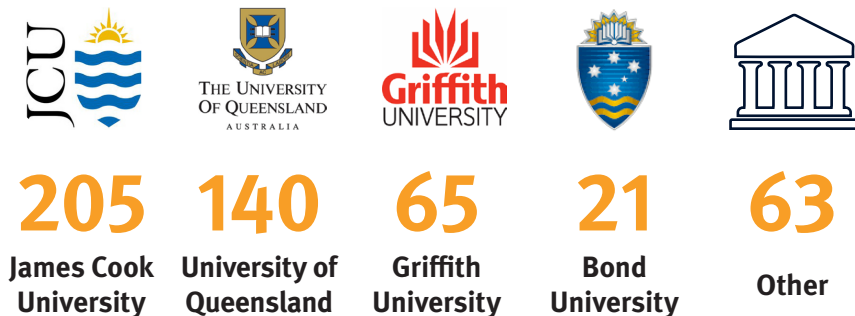

### Trainees and Fellows by university



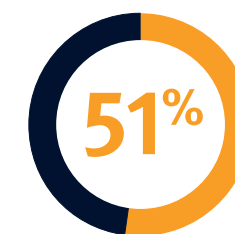

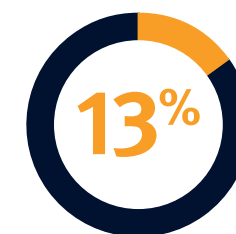

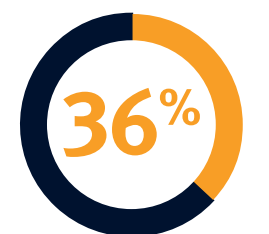
### PGY4+ practice type

Community practice

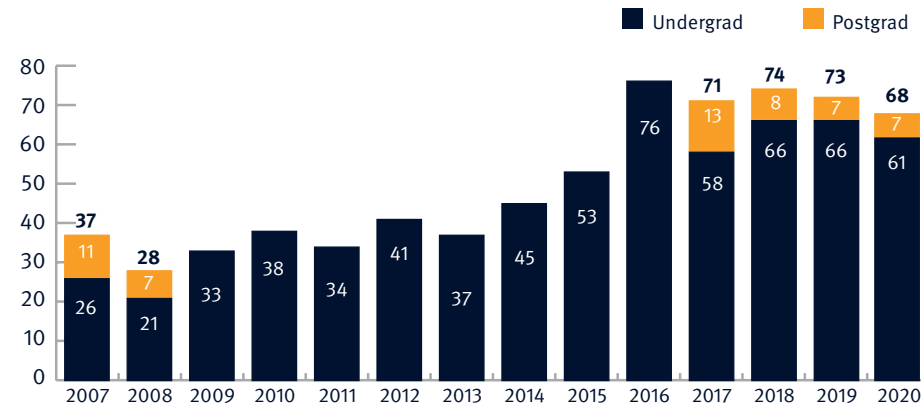

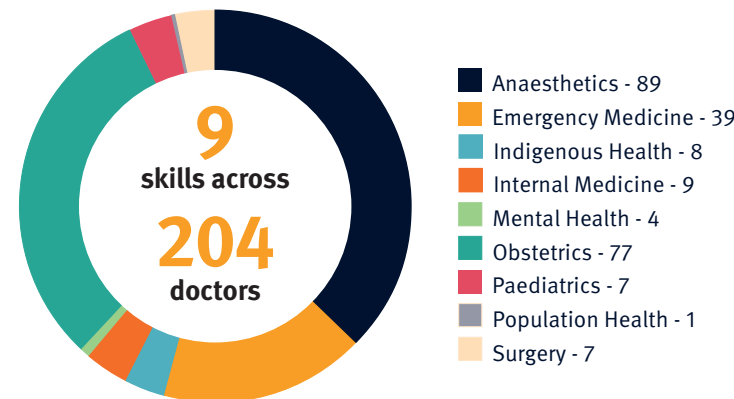

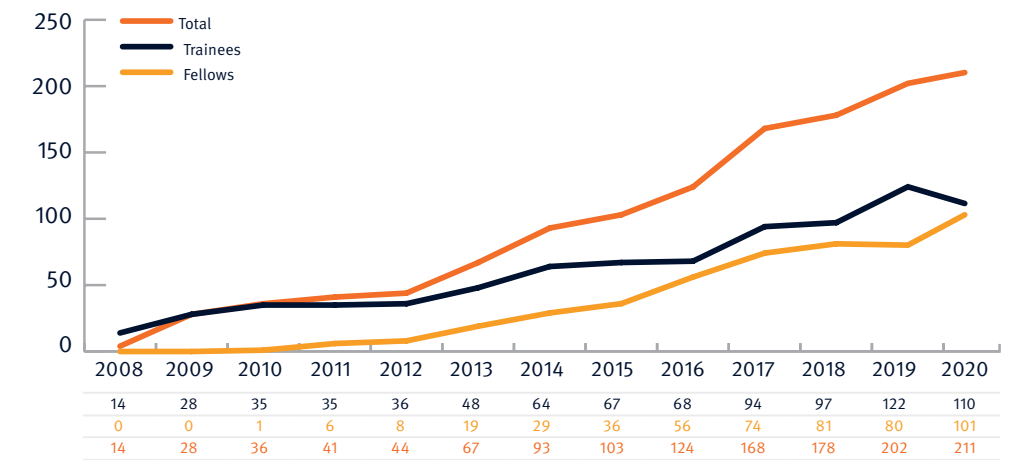
### Pathway intake by year

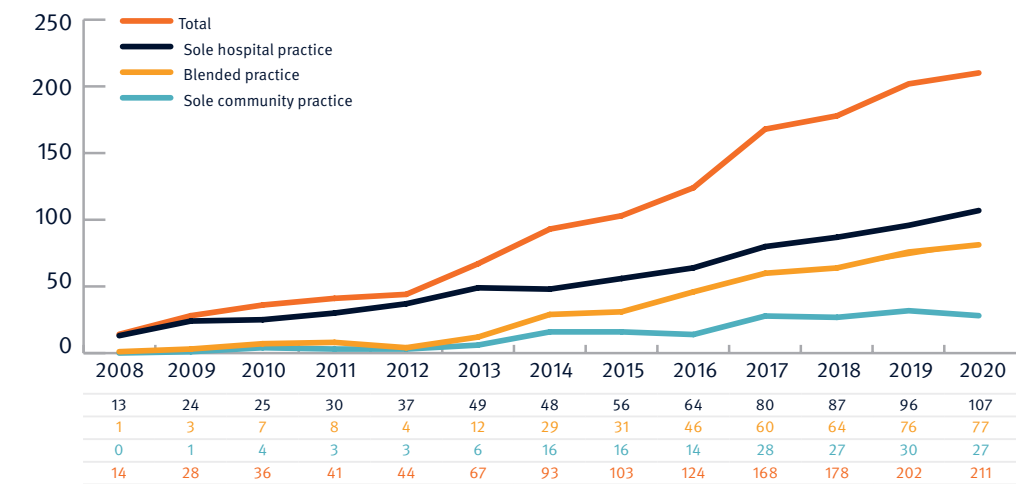

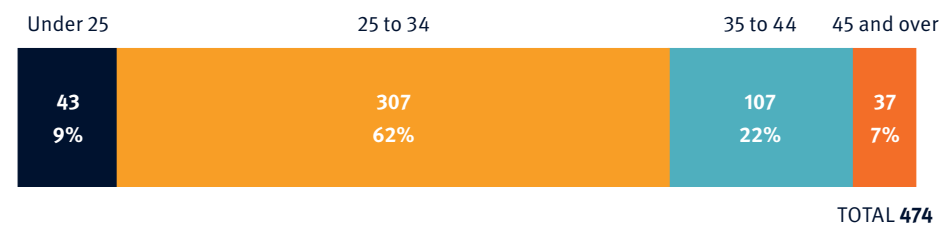

### PGY4+ Trainees and Fellows in MMM4+ | Practice type



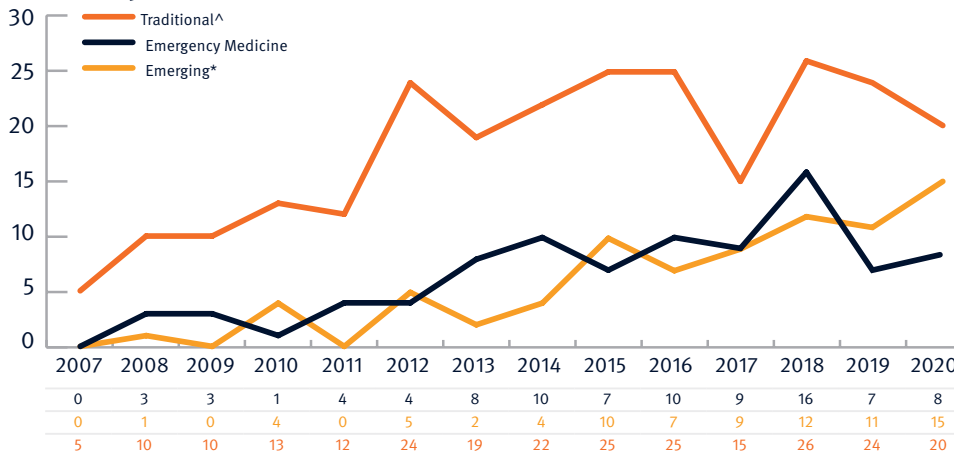

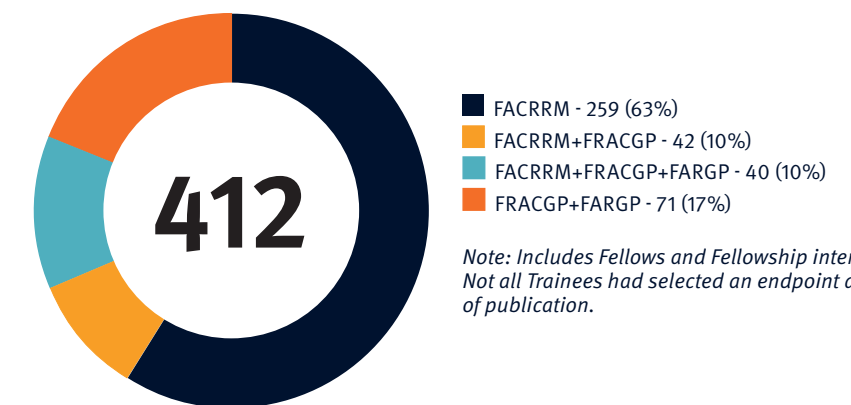
